- Medical Fitness Certificate ENG1
- Around 1000 days sea going service on board a fishing vessel. 50% on vessel more than 12.5m.
- Class 2 Deck Officer written course and exams (12 weeks at college at PD and PH)
- PLUS 5 short courses total of 45 DAYS in training (Radio Operator, Navigation, Medical First Aid, Basic STCW Fire Fighting Advanced Firefighting)
