During the Summer, work is being carried out to our offices in Admiralty Boathouse, Newlyn. You can find us and the Fishing Animateurs next to the Harbour Office.



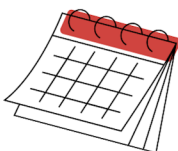
