With the deadline of 30th November set by the MCA for compulsory medical certificates, it is essential you take your ML5 or ENG1.

If you wait until after the deadline then you will not receive grandfather rights to work with a pre-existing condition.

SWHFA

South West Handline Fishermen's Association has announced it has four licences from DEFRA for members to catch Blue Fin Tuna. Four small inshore commercial fishing vessels qualified for the licenses. Crews have all had training to bleed and cool the tuna, getting it to market at a very high standard.
